

## When is a Downtown Residential Parking Permit Required?

If you live within the Residential Parking Zone and you wish to utilize on-street parking during monitored hours and/or off-street parking overnight or on weekends, you must display a Downtown Residential Parking Permit.

On-street parking is monitored from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. weekdays. Off-street parking is available for residential use from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. weekdays and on weekends.

## When is a Downtown Residential Parking Permit NOT VALID?

A Downtown Residential Parking Permit does not exempt you from 15-minute zones, fire hydrant zones, handicapped accessible spaces, bus stops, Red Zones, or other on-street restrictions or snow removal schedules.

Off-street parking is not allowed during normal working hours in City-owned, off-street facilities (8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.)

*You are responsible to notify the Planning Department of address & vehicle changes, and discontinuation of the DRP3 Program.*

## How do you apply for a Downtown Residential Parking Permit?

You must apply in person for a Downtown Residential Parking Permit at the City of Fargo Department of Planning and Development located at 200 N 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. To apply for a permit you must provide your current ND Driver's License and valid vehicle registration for your vehicle (showing your current address).

If you have recently moved to the Zone, you may apply for a temporary permit while you are waiting for your updated license and registration.

If you are a student and reside in the Zone but have not changed your permanent address, you must provide a valid college ID, driver's license, registration, and proof of residence (such as a utility bill).

## What is the Cost of a Downtown Residential Parking Permit?

The cost of a Downtown Residential Parking Permit is \$25 per month.

## What is the Residential Parking Permit Program?

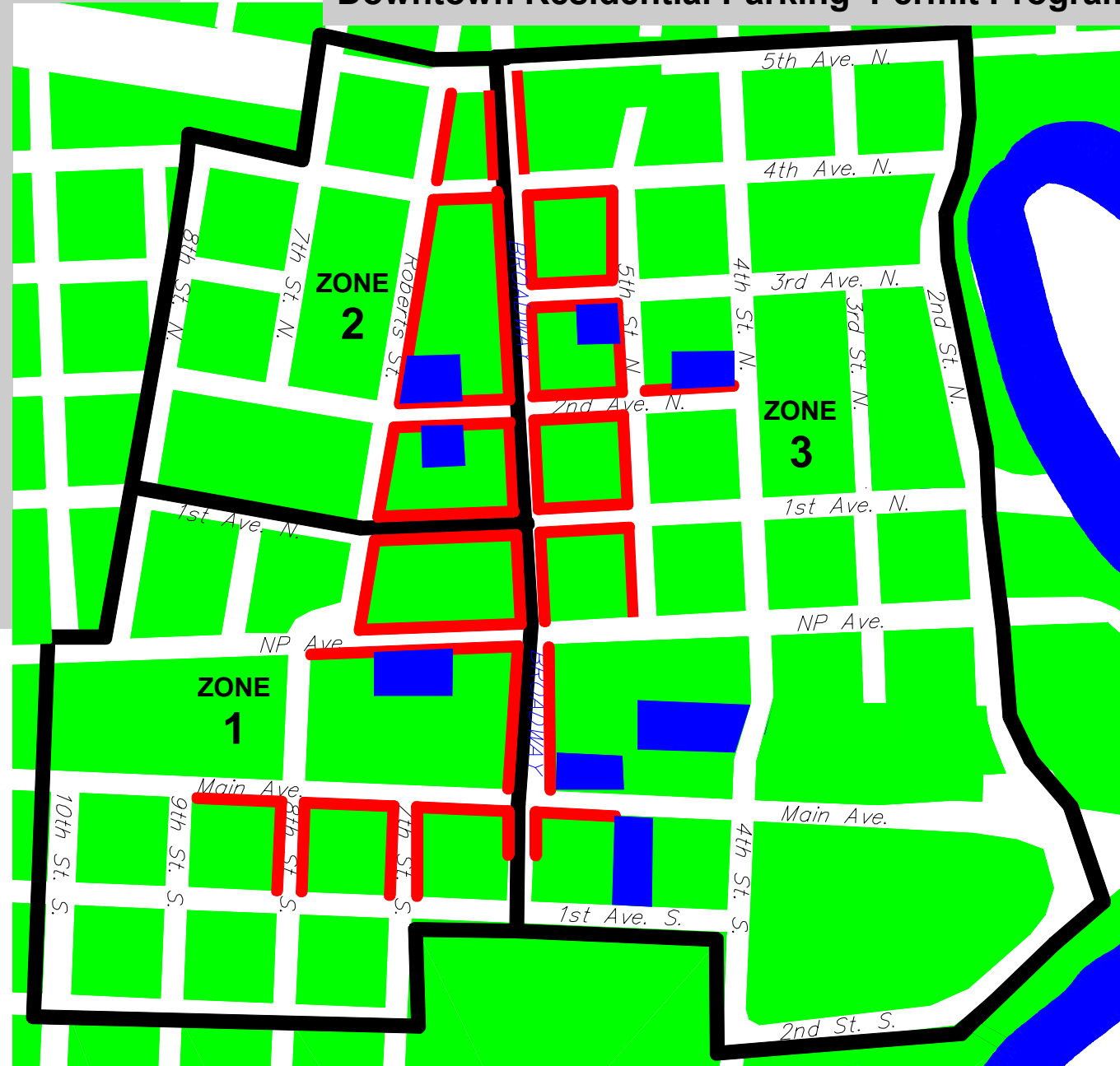
It is a combination of on-street and off-street parking designed to improve parking for Downtown residents. The program allows residents to park for extended periods of time on designated streets, and allows residents to park evenings and weekends in City-owned off-street facilities. By obtaining permits, residents in each zone may park in exception to the posted time restrictions.

While a Downtown Residential Parking Permit does not guarantee a parking space, the program greatly improves the availability of parking for Downtown residents.

## What Areas are Eligible for the Downtown Residential Parking Permit Program?

The map entitled Downtown Residential Parking Permit Program (DRP3) depicts the program area, eligible off-street parking facilities, and streets where the residential parking permit is NOT valid (Red Zone). If you park in the Red Zone, you must comply with the posted time restrictions. All other on-street 90-minutes and 2-hour parking spaces are eligible.
