Recycle these items in our curbside program

Please group each type of item (cans, glass, etc.) into brown paper bags; we cannot recycle plastic bags. Place each bag in your recycling bin. If there isn't enough room for all your bags, you can place them beside your bin or in another container. Additional recycling bins are available for purchase.

Newspapers and Magazines: We accept newspapers (including glossy inserts), magazines and small catalogs with glossy pages. Large catalogs with glued bindings should be thrown away. Place newspapers and magazines together in a paper bag or lay them loose in the bottom of the bin.

Cans: We accept aluminum and metal cans. Labels do not need to be removed. We do not accept scrap metal, foil, paint cans or other types of metal.

Plastic Bottles and Containers: We only accept plastic containers with a neck that have the #1 or #2 recycling symbol. Please rinse containers and remove caps and rings. Place #1 and #2 bottles in the same bag.

Glass: We accept clear, brown, green and blue glass bottles and jars. We do not accept light bulbs, windows, Pyrex, ceramics or any other type of glass. Please remove all caps and corks; labels may remain. Place all glass jars and bottles in one bag.

Cardboard: We accept flattened corrugated cardboard, which has a wavy material in between two pieces of cardboard. It is often found in shipping boxes. We do not accept non-corrugated boxboard, which is found in cereal and beverage boxes and other packaging. Place flattened boxes underneath or inside the bin.

Thank you for participating in the City of Fargo's curbside recycling service! The materials we recycle are a valuable resource in creating new products.

Service is provided every other week on your regular garbage collection day. Your pickup is scheduled for **Week A** (see calendar on back of postcard for exact dates). During holidays, recycling collection follows the garbage pickup schedule.

Please place the recycling container near your garbage by 8 a.m. Recycling materials will be picked up separately from your garbage. Items that are not recyclable will be left with a note explaining why they were not collected.
